Key Findings

- Realise Underground Built Heritage potential for local communities → values, meanings, identity

- Experimenting methodological approaches on sustainability transition → Living Labs, co-develop, co-create, co-manage
- Generating local culture with ICT tools interaction → creativity and social inclusion

Open Questions for Discussion

- Gaps in scientific and technical knowledge, technological capabilities and financial resources
- Absence of a specific planning legislation
- Planning as a constraint to local community development; UBH as a constraint for underground space development
- Networking does not mean researching: how to bring voluntarily different stakeholders to test project vision?
- What is the role of the communication and social communities? Would you suggest a wiki?
